Be Careful!!

 - Do you understand the vaccine order from the provider?
 - Can you choose the correct vaccine from the frig/freezer?
 - Are you using the correct formulation of vaccine for the patient's age?
 - Will you document with the CDC abbreviation?
 - Will you document correctly in MCIR?
 - Be certain you pay strict attention to EVERY detail!!
