Documenting Vaccines and MCIR

Adapted from presentation
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- Write MCIR ID number of VAR in child's chart
 - Prevents difficulty in finding correct child in MCIR
 - When
 - First time child is found in MCIR
 - Or after entering child into MCIR
 - You do NOT want multiple entries in MCIR for same child
 - Especially if child has multiple names on your chart

How to Use MCIR

- Every child must have current MCIR print out on chart when seen by provider

What does this MCIR status sheet tell you? And why is it important to your providers?

- 1. To be helpful, it must be **current** – check date it was printed
- 2. **Note to Provider** tells them whether child is
 - Up-to-date (rimmed in **Blue**)
 - Or Vaccines may be administered (rimmed in **Yellow**)
 - Or Overdue (rimmed in **Pink**)
- 3. Shows **assessment** of needed vaccines on
 - Accelerated Schedule
 - Use if child is one month or more behind
 - And on Recommended Schedule
 - If child will be up-to-date after vaccines given today

Michigan Care Improvement Registry (MCIR)

- All vaccine administered to children born after January 1, 1994 must be entered into the MCIR
- Documentation of vaccines is not complete
 - Until vaccine information is entered into MCIR!
- MCIR now expanded to include adults also
- You are encouraged to enter all vaccines given to all children and adults into MCIR
- All vaccines given to adults through VRP **MUST** be entered into MCIR

MCIR

- Confidentiality is important
 - Treat all information in MCIR as confidential
 - Includes information you enter into MCIR
 - And information you find in MCIR
 - Do not look up family and friends because you are curious
 - Do not share information you see in MCIR with friends and family

MICR & Documenting Vaccines

- What is your health center's plan for entering ALL immunizations into MCIR?
 - When is information entered?
 - How often is it entered?
 - Do immunizations get missed for entry into MCIR?
- Have more than one person trained to enter vaccines into MCIR

MICR & Documenting Vaccines

- When entering vaccines you've given
 - Be Careful -- Be sure to document the specific type of vaccine administered
 - For all vaccines
 - Especially important for vaccines in which the immunization assessment is dependent on the type of vaccine
 - (e.g. Hib vaccines)

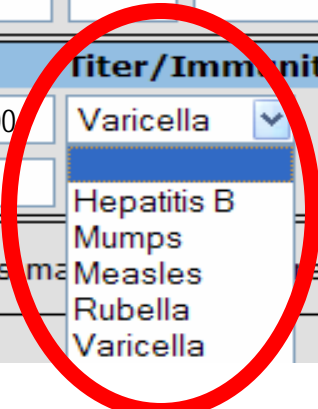
Write the date of disease on the VAR in the medical chart

MCIR and Vaccines Given Elsewhere

- Enter vaccine doses that are not already in MCIR
- This includes
 - Vaccines that were given at your office and not already entered into MCIR
 - Vaccines administered elsewhere
 - Immunization history of adolescents and adults
- Enter missing doses which come to you on confirmed medical data including
 - Green cards (child)
 - Yellow card (adults)
 - Other medical records
- Do not enter doses from a non-medical sources
 - E.g., a school letter or parent verbal report

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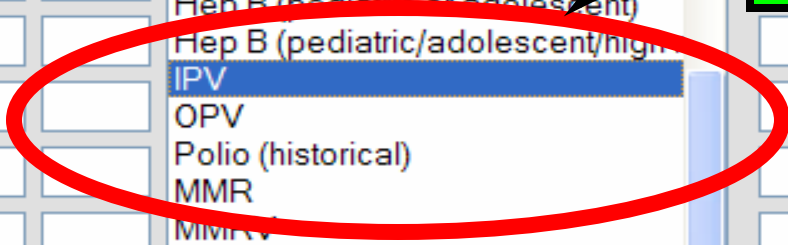

MCIR and School/Daycare Reporting

- Schools and child cares
 - Also use MCIR to report immunizations to MDCH
 - Can see (but not change!) student's immunization records that medical providers have entered
- You cannot see immunizations they have added
 - Because they are not medical providers

What if you make a mistake?

- MCIR
 - If your health center entered information into MCIR that is in error
 - You can correct it
 - If you feel you have found an error in MCIR that you did not enter
 - Contact your LHD
 - or MCIR regional office

Remember!!

- Your job of giving vaccines is not completed until all information is entered into MCIR
- MCIR is your friend.
- It helps by
 - Assessing what vaccines your patient needs
 - Running Coverage Levels for your health center
 - Communicating immunization information with all other providers in Michigan
- Do not let out-dated MCIR sheet pile up charts
 - Consider them to be worksheets
 - Discard when become outdated
